



Lamborn “Vintage VIII” Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

100% estate grown Howell Mountain, Napa Valley Cabernet

Winemaker Heidi Barrett’s tasting notes:

“Gorgeous dark blackberry color with open and intense ripe fruit aromas. This wine smells like ripe black cherries, blackberry, with a touch of sweet vanilla, carmel, toasty French oak. Quite pure in its clean aromas which lead to similar ripe, concentrated purity of flavor. It feels very fat, round, and lush in the mouth with layered flavor bursts of fully ripened mountain-top Cabernet. Tannins are moderate and ‘in check,’ leading to a mid-palate chewy texture with a light dusty finish. This is a big bold hilltop Cabernet with finesse and silkiness even though it is a big expressive wine.”

Review: 95 points

“This wine is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and was aged in French oak. It’s full-bodied, with blackberry jam, black curant, dark chocolate and toasty oak flavors. The tannin-acid balance is as fine as Napa gets. Delicious now, but give it at least six years to achieve even more complexity.” - Steve Heimoff, The Wine Enthusiast, December 2013
