



Lamborn “Mary-Hāna Rosé” Wine 2016

100% estate grown Howell Mountain Rosé of Zinfandel

Produced in the saignée (bleeding off the juice after limited contact with skins) fashion, our Rosé is both darker in color and dryer than many in the market today. The presence of color can be directly associated with flavor, of which this wine has plenty. Heidi, who tends to stay away from flowery descriptors that no one understands anyway, called this Rosé “lively” and “juicy.” We couldn’t think of any words which describe this wine better. Heidi also said, “think of the flavors in a freshly picked, totally ripe Strawberry.” So there you have it, one short sentence says it all.

We took the opportunity to name this pink wine after the two oldest (and only female) members of the fourth Lamborn generation, cousins Mary and Hāna, 13 and 12 years of age respectively.
