



Lamborn “Mary-Hāna Rosé” Wine 2018

100% estate grown Howell Mountain Rosé of Zinfandel

Produced in the saignée (bleeding off the juice after limited contact with skins) fashion and fermented dry, our Rosé is darker in color than many in the market today. The presence of color can be directly associated with flavor, of which this wine has plenty. We took the opportunity to name this pink wine after the two oldest (and only female) members of the fourth Lamborn generation, cousins Mary and Hāna, 15 and 14 years of age respectively.

“With an incredible pink hue reminiscent of Gala apples, this Rosé has a strapping aroma of bramble that becomes almost creamy in its richness and depth. On the palate it exhibits generous red berry fruits with hints of citrus zest. With no lingering residual sugar, there is no ‘stickiness’ that is associated with sweet Rosés; just lively fruit and an unforgettable crisp finish.
